



Our Community, Our Future

Our Community, Our Future is about people in Branchton, Bow Farm, Fancy Farm, Grieve Road and Pennyfern coming up with ideas they'd like to see in their community and voting to choose which ideas come to life.

£35,000 is available to spend on activities that improve health and wellbeing for local people. The project has been made possible by Community Choice funding from Scottish Government.

What could be funded?

All sorts of things could be funded – providing they will take place in the area (see other side) and contribute to the health and wellbeing of local people. This could mean:

- people being more active
- people get involved in their community
- people have more money
- people eat more healthily
- people have nicer outdoor environments
- people feel safer

Who can apply?

- A single person or group of people that live in the area
- A community group or voluntary organisation that operates in the area
- A local business based in the area
- A school based in the area

How much can you ask for?

Applications can be made for up to £5,000. There is no minimum amount. Money will be given out in March 2019 and should be spent by March 2020.

How will the successful ideas be chosen?

Everyone who puts forward an idea will be given advice and support to publicise and promote their idea. Getting publicity out there and getting people interested in your idea is essential because it is local people that will make the decision about what is funded through a voting process.

Everyone over the age of 8 who lives in the area will be eligible to vote. Voting will take place:

- Online
- In local community venues
- At an event in March 2019.

How do I get involved?
